FINANCIAL REPORT: K. Speaker provided reports to review for the month of July; July is the first month of the 2025-26 fiscal year. There is nothing major to report. M. Bosserd and K. Speaker uploaded the 2025-26 budget into BS&A.

FILE FOR AUDIT

READING OF THE BILLS by M. Bosserd

M. Bosserd provided a complete check register for the Board to review dated July 22, 2025 - August 18, 2025, totaling \$963,726.10 from the General Fund and \$112,993.76 from the Tax Account. The \$65,611 check to Southern Michigan Bank & Trust from the General Fund was the annual payment on the fire truck loan. The \$883,770.18 check to Fredonia Township was to transfer funds from Huntington Bank to Southern Michigan Bank & Trust. The voided checks from the Tax Account were test checks. K. Speaker has been working with SMB&T towards payment fraud protection via positive pay. C. Combs made a motion and K. Speaker supported to approve the bills as presented.

REPORTS:

FIRE: Chief Damon provided a report and stated there were 8 fire and 9 medical calls for the month of July 2025. Training this month: We toured the dairy farm on F Dr. with Marengo Fire Department and Homer Fire Department. Continuing Ed classes will resume in September. Equipment: The pump impeller went out on Engine 8 and P. Damon has two quotes to get it repaired. Activities: P. Damon thanked all of the firefighters that came and helped at the annual Calhoun County Fair. Personnel: Firefighter Victoria Vavra will be starting her First Responder class at the end of the month.

CEMETERY: M. Bosserd read the report provided by D. Damon. No burials or lot sales this past month. Last Thursday, August 14, 2025, D. Damon picked up one yard of gravel and shoveled it in the depressions in the center driveway of Lyon Lake Cemetery. There remain a few holes to be filled in the south drive.

ROADS: Projects are on track. Projects for next year will be confirmed at the next meeting on November 11, 2025. T. Day stated the meeting needs to be a month earlier as a November meeting will be pushing to get the road project proposals in by the December deadline. G. Crandall will talk to D. Damon about scheduling a meeting in mid-October. They need to confirm Eckford Township is on board with the 18 Mile Road project.

CODE ENFORCEMENT: Nothing new to report. The case involving the demolition of the home on 380 Lyon Lake Road is currently in the court systems.

PLANNING: The last meeting was on July 16, 2025. The August meeting was canceled as there is nothing pressing at this time. The next meeting will be on September 10, 2025.

PARKS & RECREATION: Ben Lark walked the Jenney Woods property with Ryan Reincke, Executive Director of the Calhoun Conservation District. Fredonia Township Fire Department will help with a prescribed burn next spring. Trails will need to be mowed so that vehicles can get through. There will be 3 sections to control. R. Reincke is working on finding a brush hog.

*Fire Truck Pump Repair: P. Damon explained there was a structure fire on Saturday, August 16, 2025, in Eckford Township where Engine 8's pump didn't function at full capacity. Two pieces of brass were found from the nozzle. The truck is 20 years old and the pump showed signs of corrosion and deterioration. P. Damon presented the Board with two quotes to repair the pump shaft impeller. Dependable Fire Apparatus quoted \$8,320.10 and will come to the fire station to do the repair CSI quoted \$9,099 and the truck would have to be driven to their location. Both quotes included a pump test. The current pump was tested 2-3 months ago and passed. K. Speaker made a motion and J. Miller supported to move forward with Dependable Fire Apparatus to repair the pump shaft impeller assembly.

RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A LAKE BOARD

IN ACCORDANCE WITH PART 309, INLAND LAKE IMPROVEMENTS, OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT, PA 451 OF 1994, AS AMENDED

LYON LAKE

RESOLUTION NO. 25-5

At a meeting of the Fredonia Township Board, Calhoun County, State of Michigan, held at the Fredonia Township Hall on the 18th day of August, 2025, at 6:30 PM.

PRESENT: John Miller, Kyler Speaker, Terry Day, Meg Bosserd, Cathy Combs
ABSENT:
The following resolution was offered by <u>Kyler Speaker</u> and supported by <u>John Miller</u> .
WHEREAS, Lyon Lake is an inland lake located entirely within Fredonia Township

Calhoun County, Michigan; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, Act 451 of 1994,

as amended, Part 309 ("Part 309") requires a township to establish a lake board upon receipt of a petition from greater than 2/3 of the freeholders owning lands abutting the lake; and

WHEREAS, Fredonia Township (the "Township") received a petition from greater than 2/3 of the freeholders owning lands abutting the lake under Part 309, requiring the establishment of a lake board to provide for the protection, conservation, and preservation of Lyon Lake; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the petition, and pursuant to the requirements of Part 309, the Township adopts this resolution to form a lake board to improve Lyon Lake to protect the public health, welfare, and safety, to conserve the natural resources of the State of Michigan, and to preserve property values around Lyon Lake.

NOW, THEREFORE, under the authority of and subject to the provisions of Part 309.

IT IS RESOLVED:

1. The petition received by the Township requires the Fredonia Township Board ("Township Board") to create a lake board, and said Board is therefore created by petition pursuant to

Section 30902 of Part 309. Said board shall be known as the Lyon Lake Improvement Board.

- 2. The Lyon Lake Improvement Board shall have the authority to initiate its own proceedings in accordance with Part 309 to manage aquatic invasive species and perform related activities, as well as to conduct any lawful activity that would benefit Lyon Lake as approved by the Lyon Lake Improvement Board, in all cases following all legal processes required under Part 309.
- 3. The Lyon Lake Improvement Board shall have the discretion and authority to determine the scope of the improvements to Lyon Lake and shall have the discretion and authority to establish a special assessment district including those parcels of land abutting Lyon Lake within Fredonia Township (including any backlot parcels or parcels with easement access to the lake), but shall only specially assess those parcels which will be directly benefited by the improvements to the lake.
- 4. Fredonia Township, through this resolution, does not require or compel the Lyon Lake Improvement Board to undertake any action or initiate any proceedings or special assessment districts related to Lyon Lake. All such proceedings shall be initiated, prepared, undertaken, and maintained at the discretion of the Lyon Lake Improvement Board.
- 5. Fredonia Township shall not bear any responsibility for any costs associated with the Lyon Lake Improvement Board. The Lyon Lake Improvement Board shall be responsible for all its costs, including costs to consult with legal counsel, engineers, planners, or other professional assistance, and the costs to initiate any proceedings or establish any special assessment districts, as the Lyon Lake Improvement Board may undertake.
- 6. Pursuant to Section 30903 of Part 309, the Lyon Lake Improvement Board shall consist of the following members:
 - a) The Calhoun County Water Resource Commissioner or its designee.
 - b) A member of the Calhoun County Board of Commissioners appointed by the chairperson of the county board of commissioners.
 - C) Two representatives of Fredonia Township designated by the Fredonia Township Board. The Township's Representatives shall serve at the pleasure of the Fredonia Township Board, except that the Township shall strive to follow the Lyon Lake Improvement Board's Bylaws or Articles of Incorporation, as may be established.
 - d) A member elected by the members of the Lyon Lake Improvement Board at the first meeting of the lake board. Only a person who has an interest in a land contract or a record interest in the title to land that abuts Lyon Lake is eligible to be elected to serve

in this capacity. An organization composed of and representing the majority of lakefront property owners on Lyon Lake may submit up to three names to the lake board, from which the lake board shall make its selection.

- 7. The Lyon Lake Improvement Board shall be responsible for the creation of its own Bylaws and Articles of Incorporation, as it deems necessary.
- 8. All prior resolutions and parts of prior resolutions insofar as they conflict with this resolution are hereby rescinded.

RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO ESTABLISH SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT FOR STREET LIGHTING NEAR LYON LAKE

No. 25-7

At a meeting of the Fredonia Township Board held on August 18, 2025 at the Township Hall, the following resolution was offered by <u>Terry Day</u> and supported by <u>Meg Bosserd.</u>

WHEREAS, Fredonia Township has previously utilized a special assessment district to defray the cost of street lighting in the area of Lyon Lake, within the Township; and

WHEREAS, there continues to be a need for street lighting around Lyon Lake.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Fredonia Township Board of Trustees tentatively intends to proceed to provide a street lighting system within the area of Lyon Lake under 1954 Public Act 188 (PA 188), as amended, and to defray the cost and expenses of the same by special assessment on the lands and premises in the Township benefitted by the lighting, as depicted in attached Exhibit 1.
- 2. The Township Supervisor (or his designee) is authorized and directed to investigate and prepare and confirm a report showing the necessary plans, specifications, cost and expenses of providing a street lighting system within the Township. The report shall make recommendations on the following:
 - A. The cost and expenses of the proposed street lighting system that should be paid by special assessment on the properties benefitted; and
 - B. The extent of the street lighting system district and the boundaries of the special assessment district; and
 - C. Any other fact, information or recommendation that will aid the Township Board in determining whether to proceed with the proposed special assessment district.

Upon completion of the report, it shall be filed with the Township Clerk and copies delivered to the Township Board.

3. Fredonia Township shall hold a Public Hearing on September 15, 2025, at Fredonia Township Hall, 8803 17 Mile Road, Marshall, MI 49068 at 5:00 pm to receive comments or objections to the petition, the creation of a special assessment district for the purpose of the installation, improvement and maintenance of a street lighting system around Lyon Lake, and the cost estimate.
